

What is EU funding?




- English: Grant, Subsidy
 - direct financial contributions from the EU budget
- For whom?
 - Public organisations, associations, NGOs, companies, SMEs etc.
- What for?
 - A project meaning a specific activity

What is EU funding?



- 7 year funding periods
- EU Programmes have their own rules
 - Programmes in itself are often not comparable
 - Incoherent structure huge point of critizism
 - IPMA methods help you structure the project though

Consortium = some Programmes ask you to form a Consortium. That means, that you have to find some other project partners who are facing similiar challenges and who are willing to cooperate with you within a project

Lead Partner= every Consortium has a Lead Partner. That LP gets much more budget, but
is also in charge of communication with Programme.



Work Package Leader= many projects need to be structured via WP's. Every WP has Leader who reports to LP about Progress etc.


Associated Partner (Project Observers) = when Consortium is required, often also associated partners are required. Those partners do not have any budget in the project, but they act as supporters of it and get permanent information etc. Eg.: NGO's, Regional Organizations etc.

EU FUNDING LANDSCAPE 2014-2020



Danube Strategic Project Fund

Part-financed by the European Union and the City of Vienna

- A pilot initiative to fund
 - to fund strategic transnational projects in the Danube Region
 - focuses primarily on innovative pre-mature projects
 - projects which could not be funded so far
 - projects which respond to the actual needs in the Danube Region
 - projects which establishes links to the Adriatic-Ionian Region (EUSAIR)




IPA Serbia – Bosnia and Herzegovina









→ Project Idea Nr. 1

Greening of flat roofs

- Flat roofs in very urban city areas should be planted with different kinds of plants.
- The choise of plants should also differ, not only ornamental or decorative but also useful kind of plants should be planted on the roof..
- One of the important parts of this projects is the scientifical analasys of the possible issues or problems of sustainable gardening and biodiversity of the roofs.
- Moreover one exemple garden on one roof should be made as activity of this project.







→ Project Idea Nr. 2

Rescue Services - Experience Exchange

- The bigger cities in the Danube Region have an proffessional rescue service teams (full-time employees).
- The exchange of the the growing challanges of these services are mostly done through different visits which unfortenatelly do not take place very offten or very sporadically.
- The aim of this project is the establishment of an professional and regular exchange of information (best practices) between the rescue services in the Danube Region. One of the important activities of the project is an international conference organized for the representatives of participating organisations.







→ Project Idea Nr. 3

Establishment of a new liner shipping

- The aim of this project is to establish a new liner shipping on one of the Austrian lakes that will be operating on a regular basis and during the whole year. Till know only excursion boats were traveling throughout the sommer months on this lake.
- Besides the shortening of the walking or driving distances of the lokal citisens, the main goal is would also be to reduce the CO2 emmission through the new technology ships operating on this lake.







→ Project Idea Nr. 4

Youth and culture

- The aim of this project is to develop concepts for increassing the interesst of the young people for the cultural heritage of the Europe.
- Main focus would be on development of a documentary series on the European capitals.
- The series should not be shown on TV only but also spread throught the different online media. It should be possible to get additional information on the internet or throught an app.







→ Project Idea Nr. 5

Energie & Urban Planning

- There should be a research done on how much the different aspects of energie can affect the urban planning.
- Not only the hisorical data should be analysed but also the concepts on how this topic needs be handled in the future have to be developed.
- One of the main aspects that should be take into consideration is the common approach of the main European capitals in this regard.







Details – INTERREG

Interreg is a series of five programmes to stimulate cooperation between regions in the <u>European Union</u>, funded by the <u>European Regional Development Fund</u>. The first Interreg started in 1989. Interreg IV covered the period 2007–2013. Interreg V (2014-2020) covers all 28 EU Member States, 3 participating <u>EFTA countries</u> (Norway, Switzerland, Liechtenstein), 6 accession countries and 18 neighbouring countries. It has a budget of EUR 10.1 billion, which represents 2.8% of the total of the <u>European Cohesion Policy</u> budget. Since the non EU countries don't pay EU membership fee, they contribute directly to Interreg, not through ERDF.

Interreg is designed to stimulate cooperation between member states of the European Union on different levels. One of its main targets is to diminish the influence of national borders in favor of equal economic, social and cultural development of the whole territory of the European Union.[citation needed]

The Interreg initiative is designed to strengthen economic, social and territorial cohesion throughout the European Union, by fostering the balanced development of the continent through cross-border, transnational and interregional cooperation. Special emphasis has been placed on integrating remote regions with those that share external borders with the candidate countries.
