# Structure of the Polish "CAF Resource Centre" - establishment process

 Head of the Civil Service and Director of the Public Administration
 Department (MIA) since 2004 in EUPAN
 DG meetings

2004

•Function of "National CAF Correspondent" appointed in the Civil Service Department, providing services to the HSC 2004

•Free of charge support in CAF usage cofinanced with EFS; division was sustained – HSC provided support to civil service offices, MIA to local administration



#### Structure of the Polish "CAF Resource Centre"

- establishmeric proces

•Access to CAF External Feedback for local process for loc National Coordinator (MIA) and retrained group of EFAC

•The function of National CAF Coordinator delegated to the public body (NIST), subordinated to the MIA

#### CAF state of play in Poland



- 1. CAF resource centre not established as such.
   Instead: 3 cooperating actors:
- National CAF Correspondent
- National CAF Coordinator for local gov't
- 39 CAF experts
- 2. More than 400 CAF users (according to EIPA CAF Resource Centre data base)
- 3. More than 75 effective CAF Users

Promotion of CAF among the main entities influencing the civil service system: Public Sector Council and all DGs



Research on CAF knowledge, interest and needs among the DGs



Training events for possible CAF users and possible CAF leaders for civil service offices and local gov't administration

#### CAF promotion – steps undertaken after 2017



Updating CAF External Feedback procedure for self-gov't



Promoting CAF External Feedback procedure during the meetings with the potential applicants and on NIST websites



Ensuring latest news, documents, FAQ on CAF on CAF website



On process – action to ensure PEF for the whole public administration



#### **Lessons learned**

# Polish experience in CAF promotion and implementation – lessons learned

Limited access to EU funds = Limited possibility to support offices for free

Gradual decreasing in numbers of the CAF implementation

Limited interest in CAF among offices

Diffusion of responsibility for CAF

Decreasing interest of policy makers to allocate resources for CAF promotion and implementation

Less resources (human and financial) ensured for CAF promotion and implementation

# Polish experience in CAF promotion and implementation – lessons learned cont.

- 1. Leaders' commitment is crucial for CAF implementation and the method repeatability in organisation
- 2. External financial resources (e.g. ESF) are often the condition of effective CAF implementation
- 3. Network of experts representing public and private sectors is an advantage
- 4. CAF is not the *perpetuum mobile*. People changed, leaders changed permanent information and promotion actions are necessary
- 5. One body responsible for CAF promotion and implementation to avoid the diffusion of responsibility or strong commitment to cooperation between bodies responsible, stable access to resources (human and financial) the best possible solution
- 6. PEF is important incentives for offices to use CAF
