

What is it?

- Developed 2007 by member states as common goal
- Instrument to improve quality of local governance
- Involves states, associations and local authorities
- Based on the Charter of Local Governance and its protocol
- Based on 12 Principles of Good and Democratic Governance

- Accountability



European Label of Governance Excellence

ELoGE.

To local authorities having achieved a high overall level of good governance in relation to the 12 Principles.

The award is assigned by a **national or regional Stakeholders' Platform**

The national or regional platform is accredited by the stakeholders' platform of the Council of Europe.

A tool for raising awareness and motivation

The tool:

- -A description of the good governance Principles
- _a list of the activities that help a municipality to comply with each principle;
- -A **self-assessment model for municipalities** to identify the level of maturity for each principle.
- -The label in form of the crystal dodecahedron engraved with the 12 principles

Role of municipality:

- -Get in contact with the national accredited body
- -Adopt officially to the strategy (or select a number of priority principles)
- -Make a self-assessment of level of maturity
- -Record the evidence of the self-assessment
- -Have a Feed back session with label experts

How does it work?

Stepp 1

Self-Evaluation - 3 Questionaires

- 1.Level of compliance of the 12Principles within the administration (Selfevaluation)
- 2. Opinion, satisfaction of citizens (Citizen Survey)
- 3. Opinion, satisfaction of politicians (Interviews with elected local officials)

Stepp 2

Assessment of results from questionaires through external experts

- feed back, follow up messures

Stepp 3

Be awarded with **EloGE** – promotion, publication, exchange
