Priorities and Objectives of the Sustainable Development Strategy

Environment Rehabilitation

- Integrated waste management including a strategy for segregation and reducing of waste
- Identification of problematic areas affected by deforestation causing erosion, leading to land loss, especially agricultural one;
- Afforestation of the areas identified above, with suitable vegetation to enable the protection of the soil from erosion;
- Prohibition of wastewater discharge to water surfaces (rivers, lakes);

Tourism and Economic Development Promotion

- Diversification and specialization of the economy focusing on mountain tourism, eco-tourism, agro-tourism, and agro-processing



Raise local capacities by training HR and/or hiring external expertise

- Promoting the development of tourism sector and of local capacities;

Improvement of the road Infrastructure

- Integration of the municipality of Gramsh in the green itineraries at the city level and at the regional level through light and tourist infrastructure.



Improvement of Public and Social Services

- Regeneration of parks of different categories and for different groups: playground, green park, public space in the neighborhood, etc.;
- Opening of an "info-point" in the city, aiming to promote main touristic attractions of the municipality, and of the social-cultural programs held.
