

About the project






- Families and children at risk/young people and their communities
- Professionals working in family strengthening services both day care services and interdisciplinary mobile teams -(social workers, psychologists, parental assistants, educators, social assistants, police)
- Representatives of local authorities and state duty bearers (mayoralties, districts and ministries)
- Civil servants working on parenting support on local, regional and national levels
- Directors of the Social Assistance and Family Protection Departments
- Civil society organisations



Vulnerable groups within the project



- families at risk of separation
- children and young people at risk of institutionalisation
- victims of neglect and abuse
- children left behind by migrant parents
- young care leavers left without support to continue their education, to find a job and secure adequate housing conditions



Vulnerable groups within the project



- Dubăsari and Căușeni include regions affected by extreme poverty and a high migration rate.
- Situated at the border to Transnistria, the region of Dubăsari is considered increasingly vulnerable to political conflicts; in this region the project will directly involve civil servants and NGO staff of the day care services and the mobile team who work with children of vulnerable families from Transnistria who often cross the river Dniester to Moldova to secure access to education and support for their children.



Results



3 workshops on the local level with participation of experts in youth work were organized in November 2020:

- Dubăsarii Vechi district 14 participants (4 experts from CONCORDIA Moldova, one expert from CONCORDIA Austria and other 3 experts from other Austrian NGOs, one expert from CONCORDIA Romania, and 5 experts from Social Directorate from Dubăsarii Vechi);
- Căușeni district 11 participants (4 experts from CONCORDIA Moldova, one expert from CONCORDIA Austria and other 3 experts from other Austrian NGOs, one expert from CONCORDIA Romania, one specialist from the National Council for Youth, and one expert of the Social Directorate from Căușeni)

Results



In the municipality of Chişinău- 17 participants (5 experts from CONCORDIA Moldova, one expert from CONCORDIA Austria and other 3 experts from other Austrian NGOs, one expert from CONCORDIA Romania, 5 specialist from the Municipal Resource Center for Youth, Municipal Youth Council, Youth Center Chişinău);

- Following the workshops two reflection sessions took place in order to include best practices in the development of a toolkit regarding youth work services;
- Focus group with young people to involve them in the developing of toolkit.
